## **Bring the family! It's movie time at the Rawlings Public Library**

Classics! Classics! And more classics! Beginning on April 9 at 4 p.m., the InfoZone News Museum in partnership with the Robert Hoag Rawlings Public Library will show a classic movie on the 10'x18' projection screen. Bring the entire family for an opportunity to relax from the weekly grind.

The movies, shown on the second Friday of each month, will feature movies based on books like *20,000 Leagues Under the Sea*, *Ivanhoe*, *Dr. Jeckyll and Mr. Hyde*, *Jayne Eyre* and many more.

April's featured movie is based on the book *The Count of Monte Cristo*, which is about Edmond Dantes (portrayed by Jim Caviezel of *The Passion of the Christ*) an honest sailor, who plans to marry his lifelong love Mercedes. His plans are shattered when his best friend Fernando (portrayed by Guy Pearce of *The Time Machine*), who wants Mercedes for himself, deceives him. Set up to be unlawfully sentenced to the infamous island prison of Chateau D'If, Dantes is trapped for 13 years, but is able to make friends with a fellow prisoner who sheds light on his situation. With the help of his new friend, Dantes plots and succeeds in his mission to escape from prison, whereupon he transforms himself into the mysterious and wealthy Count of Monte Cristo. With cunning ruthlessness, Dantes finds his place in society and finds vengeance.

The movie is from Touchstone Home Entertainment and is rated PG-13. The featured movie will be shown at 4 p.m. and is free to the public. Seating is limited and reservations must be made. To make a reservation, please call 562-5604.
