**Iraq war topic of discussion
Politician, Muslim, political science
and U.S. representative to Iraq represented**

PUEBLO – Safety of troops, politics and religion are on the minds of many Americans as the war in Iraq continues. Visit the InfoZone News Museum at 7 p.m. on Wednesday, July 21 and listen to four panelists who may be able to shed light on some of your questions.

The InfoZone and Robert Hoag Rawlings Public Library are hosting a distinguished group of panelist from a variety of backgrounds. Panelists include City Councilman Jeff Chostner, who will offer a politician's point of view, author and national speaker Asma Hasan offering insight from the Muslim viewpoint, Lt. Col. Mark Gose, a political science professor at the Air Force Academy and CSU-Pueblo, and Jim Oliver, a quality assurance specialist with the U.S. Department of Defense who recently returned from Iraq.

The discussion will last an hour and a half, with each panelist receiving 15 minutes to speak. The audience will have the chance to ask questions during a 30 minute question and answer session following the panel discussion.

Asma Hasan, author of *American Muslims: The New Generation* and *Why I Am a Muslim: An American Odyssey*, will also be available for a book signing following the event. Both books will be available at special pricing of \$10 for her first book *The New Generation* and \$15 for her newest release, which has been featured on CNN's book channel. Hasan has been on Fox News and the History Channel as well as speaking at Ivy League schools like Harvard and Yale.
