Film examines a marriage in crisis

Well-to-do, sophisticated couple, Elsa and Michele, have a 20 year-old daughter, Alice, and enough money for Elsa to leave her job and fulfill an old dream of studying art history in **Days and Clouds**, the InfoZone's independent film for January, scheduled to be shown at 7 p.m. on Saturday, Jan. 17. After Elsa graduates, however, their lives change. Michele confesses he hasn't worked in two months and was fired by the company he founded years ago. Elsa overcomes her initial shock by pouring extra energy into facing the crisis while Michele, exhausted by an unsuccessful job hunt, lets himself go, alternating between vivacity and apathy. The growing distance between them eventually leads to a break-up. Only when they are apart do they realize that they risk losing their most precious possession: the love that binds them. **Days and Clouds** is an award-winning drama from Italy. The film is not rated and is in Italian with English subtitles.

The InfoZone News Museum is an interactive news museum, one of only four news museums in the world. The InfoZone is free to the public and is funded by the Pueblo City-County Library District, The Rawlings Foundation and The Pueblo Chieftain. "Public Occurrences Both Foreign and Domestick" was the title of the first newspaper published in the Americas. It was published for the first time and last on September 25, 1690, in Boston, Massachusetts, and was intended to be published monthly, "or, if any Glut of Occurrences happen, oftener." It was printed by Richard Pierce and edited by Benjamin Harris, who had previously published a newspaper in London. The paper contained four six-by-ten inch pages.

InfoZone Book to a Movie Club

Join us for a collection of wonderful movies that all started out in book form. We'll be showing the films on the InfoZone's big screen at 7 p.m. on the third Wednesday of each month.

January's selection, scheduled for Wednesday, Jan. 21, is *Persepolis*. Marjane (voiced by Chiara Mastroianni) just wants to be an ordinary kid, but that isn't easy in 1978 Iran. This profound animated film, rated PG-13, follows Marjane's childhood in a repressive society, her adolescence in France and return to Tehran as an adult.

Based on Marjane Satrapi's autobiographical graphic novel, this Oscar nominee for Best Animated Feature Film also features the vocal talents of Catherine Deneuve and Simon Abkarian.

In 2010, it is projected that there will be 6,924 children in this age group and, in 2015, there will be 7,679 children age 2 and younger.

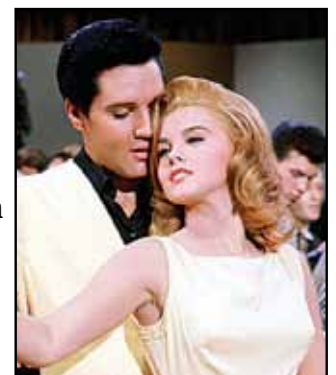
